Chest tomb, late C18 or early C19, ashlar with south side plaque framed by arched-head panel each side with cherub heads over seated figures, plaque in parted curtain frame, drapery half-shrouding urn to each side. Rounded corners with leaf decoration. Similar north side plaque but descending doves under cherub heads. Moulded base and cornice with fluted frieze.

Chest tomb, late C18, ashlar with oval 'north side plaque to I. Buckell with cherub heads in spandrels and draped urn each side. South plaque to J. Buckell, oval with ribbon drop each side. Lyre ends with husk drops. Moulded cornice.

2/334 R. Lovelock monument in churchyard, about 1m south east of I.

Chest tomb, c1785, ashlar with rectangular north panel flanked by finely carved flaming urns with festoons over. Plain south panel with flanking strips. Lyre ends with fruit and foliage drops, scrolled feet and oval end plaques. Moulded base and cornice. Earliest decipherable date 1784 to R. Lovelock.

Chest tomb, c1825, pennant stone with plaque each side, urns flanking with drapery over, moulded base and moulded ridged capstone. Lyre ends with husk drops. Earliest recorded date 1823 to Juleeann Shellard.

Chest tomb, late C18, ashlar with 2 circular north side plaques, books in centre spandrel and torches to outer spandrels. Similar south side but with centre festoon and outer paterae. Rounded fluted angles. Moulded base and cornice.

of nave of Church of St. Mary

Chest tomb, late C18, pennant stone with 2 shaped north side plaques with husk drops. Plainer 2 south side plaques. Lyre ends with husk drops. Moulded base and capstone.

2/338 Unidentified monument in churchyard about 2m south east of Coates

tomb, south of nave of Church of St. Mary

Chest tomb, mid to later C18, ashlar with fielded square side panels flanked by strips with floral drop to north side and drapery to south. Baluster corners, moulded base and capstone.

Chest tomb, later C18, ashlar with large oval south plaque with bar each side and 4 fielded spandrel panels, 2 ovals to north side with cherub head in centre over floral drop. Baluster corners, moulded base and capstone.

Chest tomb, later C18, ashlar with oval plaque each side flanked by floral and foliate scrolls. Fielded piers to west end, east end chamfered angles with floral drop. Moulded base and capstone.
